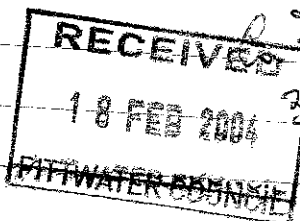

Dear Sir,

I am writing regarding the proposed re-zoning of Heydon Estate and Uniting Church Land at Ingle-side and Elanora Heights. While my objections are along the lines of most other objectors to this proposal i.e.: environmental, traffic in Wesley St; double storied houses totally out of place in a bush setting; I have another objection that I consider to be life threatening. Ten years ago we had a bushfire that raced through the land at the rear of Ingle-side road and Wesley street which totally devastated

the area that the proposed development now occupies. In the event of a similar occurrence, I wonder what escape route would be available to the people living in the dwelling zones that are proposed. The terrain is such that they would have to scale a rock face at the rear of their properties in order to escape any fire at the front of their homes.
