The fact that the school is nearby and will increase the amount of construction vehicles past the school is dangerous. Additional traffic, if completed, would also be unfavorable.

The junction onto Iris St and the the junction at Warringah Rd is already at unable to cope with the existing traffic at school zone times and the additional trucks and subsequent traffic would exacerbate the situation.
