Re: Proposed rezoning of Heydon Estate and Uniting Church land, Ingleside and Elanora Heights (ref R005/03 and R006/03)

Dear Madam,

In reply to your letter dated January 29th,2004, there are some concerns relating to the proposal.

Firstly, I feel these two applications should be considered separately but in conjunction with one another.

- A) Heydon Estate Proposal:-
 - 1. A two entry access to the proposed residential lots from Ingleside Road for Fire Protection as this area was severely burnt during the 1994 fires.
 - 2. Homes should be restricted to one storey in height to preserve the appearance of the area.
 - 3. All homes to be connected to the sewerage system.
- B) United Church Land:-

As this land was donated to the church by Sir Frederick Stewart for "Special Purposes", there is a suggestion that Pittwater Council purchase it for a park and recreational facilities.

However, as the rezoning of the area is under discussion, some points to consider are:-

- 1. Road development to be restricted to access only the new land devision. It could also be accessed only from Ingleside Road.
- 2. No buses be permitted to use the new road or existing track behind Wesley Street homes to access the existing Camp Site.
- 3. The remaining United Church Land to be used as at present for "Special Purposes"
- 4. The church owned bushland be restored to its natural beauty and maintained.
