Reasons for referral

This application seeks consent for the following:

- Construction / development works within 5 metres of a tree or
- New residential works with three or more dwellings. (RFB's, townhouses, seniors living, guesthouses, etc). or
- Mixed use developments containing three or more residential dwellings.

Officer comments

The proposal is for alterations and additions to the existing building, fitout and use for veterinary hospital.

The application is assessed by Landscape Referral against Warringah Development Control Plan 2011, including but not limited to the following clauses:

- D1 Landscaped Open Space and Bushland Setting
- E1 Preservation of Trees or Bushland Vegetation

The existing site supports small existing garden bed areas with no existing trees. Sparse vegetation occupies the existing garden beds.

A Landscape Plan plan is provided that proposes the re-establishment of mass planting to the proposed landscape areas and this is acceptable and suitable for the site.

The proposal is therefore supported.

Landscape Completion

Landscaping is to be implemented in accordance with the approved Landscape Plans DA-17 and DA-18.

Prior to the issue of any Occupation Certificate details shall be submitted to the Principal Certifying Authority certifying that the landscape works have been completed in accordance with any conditions of consent.

Reason: Environmental amenity.

ON-GOING CONDITIONS THAT MUST BE COMPLIED WITH AT ALL TIMES

Landscape Maintenance

If any landscape materials/components or planting under this consent fails, they are to be replaced with similar materials/components. Trees, shrubs and groundcovers required to be planted under this consent are to be mulched, watered and fertilised as required at the time of planting.

If any tree, shrub or groundcover required to be planted under this consent fails, they are to be replaced with similar species to maintain the landscape theme and be generally in accordance with the approved Landscape Plan and any conditions of consent.

All weeds are to be removed and controlled in accordance with the NSW Biosecurity Act 2015.

Reason: To maintain local environmental amenity.
